Meals can be served in your room or you may eat in the Dining Room.

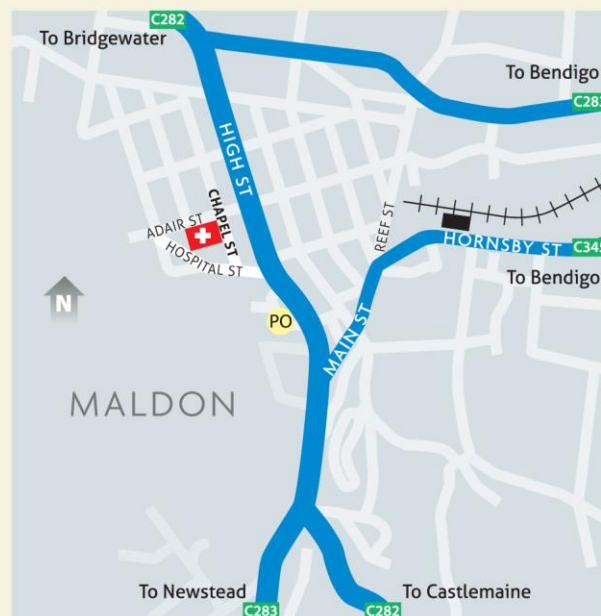
Meals are prepared at Castlemaine Health but limited options can be provided.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

All medications you are currently taking including herbal supplements and vitamins (please hand to the Registered Nurse in charge on admission).

Please also bring

- Personal toiletries
- Glasses, hearing aid or walking aid (if used)
- Personal clothing

- Pensioner health benefit card
- Health insurance details
- Medicare card
- Department of Veterans Affairs card
- Advance Care Plan

Electrical Equipment

Televisions are provided for patients. However, all other electrical equipment must be safety checked by the hospital's appointed electrician prior to use. We ask that you consider the well-being of other patients and residents when using any equipment.

Valuables

We strongly encourage you to leave valuables, such as jewellery, wallets or large amounts of cash at home. The hospital accepts no responsibility for your items.

Laundry

Laundering of the hospital's linen etc is undertaken at the facilities of Castlemaine Health. All other personal items will need to be laundered by your carer.

Pets

Unfortunately due to Government regulations, pets are not allowed in the acute section of the Hospital.

Mail / Telephone Calls

Mail addressed to you, care of the hospital will be delivered to your room.

Phones located on the bedside tables are for incoming calls only.

Newspapers / Kiosk Trolley

Newspapers may be ordered through the Maldon Newsagent.

A kiosk trolley will visit patients once a week for small purchases.
