Allied health services

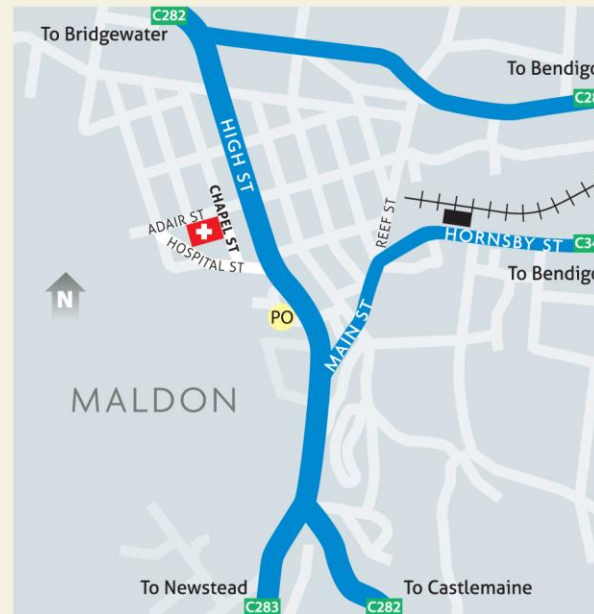
Including Podiatry – other services can be accessed via referral including physiotherapy, generalist counselling, dietician, occupational therapy. Contact your local doctor for referral.

Acute Care

Medical, nursing & allied health is provided in the 4 bed acute wing. Home and community based services are linked via discharge planning to provide care and support on discharge.

Residential Care

Residential Care is available for 16 residents in Mountview Home with predominately single rooms with ensuite. We offer comfort and a home like ambience for the most dependent members of our community.

Jessie Bowe House also provides residential care with 12 single rooms with ensuite. A large lounge and dining area offer supervised care whilst encouraging independence and companionship.

Urgent Care

A walk-in, nurse led clinic focused on the treatment of injuries or illnesses requiring immediate care, but not serious enough to require an Emergency Department visit. A doctor is on call.



District Nursing Services.

Maldon Hospital offers a District Nursing Service 7 days per week to support your health in your home. The Registered Nurses will visit you at home on arrangement to provide a range of health care.
