

We hold a regular church service; if you are interested please ask the staff for a day and time.

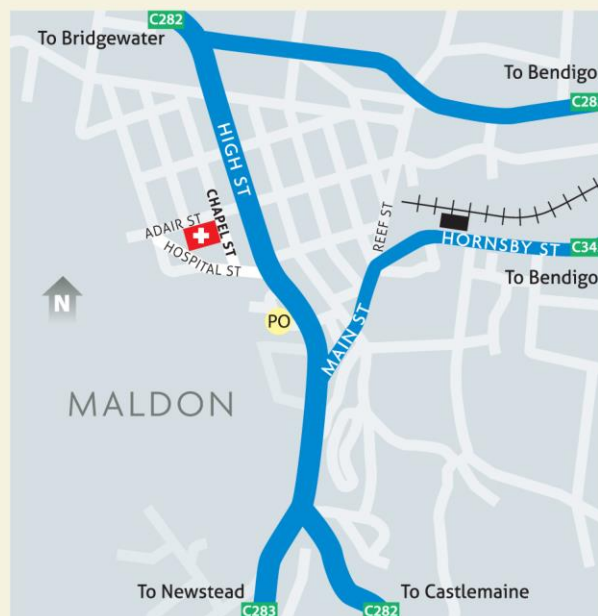
The service is led by representatives from local churches on an alternating roster.
